## HIGH SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM (HSSP) QUICK REFERENCE GUIDE

**Who is eligible?** High school seniors and graduates who have no full-time college history. *Exceptions*: students enrolled in a joint high school and college program.

Minimum Academic Requirements: 3.0 GPA and 1240 SAT or 26 ACT

**Scholarship Types:**

1	100% Tuition/Fees at Any School
2	\$18K Annual for Tuition/Fees at Any School
7	100% In-State Tuition/Fees (Public School)  NOTE: May be converted to a 3-Year Type 2 to attend a private or out-of-state school.

## **HSSP 9-Step Process:**

- Step 1: AFROTC/RRUC (HSSP Office) receives and quality checks (QCs) prospects' online application and documents completed via <a href="www.AFROTC.com">www.AFROTC.com</a>. Applicant becomes eligible to proceed through the HSSP cycle once all required application responses and documents are received.
- Step 2: Eligible applicants are placed on interview roster located notified via the Air Liaison Officer (ALO) website at https://aloweb.usafa.edu/.
- Step 3: Applicants' administrative detachment (based on nearest zip code) is notified via ALO website to schedule the interview.
- Step 4: Administrative detachments conduct the interview and forward a completed AF Form 4060 electronically to HQ AFROTC/RRUC no later than 30 DAYS after initial notification.
- Step 5: AFROTC/RRUC receives and QCs the completed AF Form 4060. The applicant then meets the next available board.
- Step 6: The selection board convenes. The applicants are ranked amongst their peers based on a "whole-person" concept. Only interviews with a 3 or better rating, on a 1-5 scale, meets the board.
- Step 7: Applicants are notified via email of their application status (conditional offer; non-select; rolled over to subsequent board).
- Step 8: Selectees' names are populated and distributed to the Department of Defense Medical Evaluation Review Board (DoDMERB) to initiate process. Selectees are instructed to complete their online DoDMERB account and medical examination. Selectees are urged to complete this step regardless of final decision to accept the scholarship offer due to lengthy DoDMERB process. Must be DoDMERB qualified to contract.
- Step 9: Selectees must submit their Letter of Admissions and accept their scholarship offer via the online application account no later than 31 May.
